## Carbon Monoxide

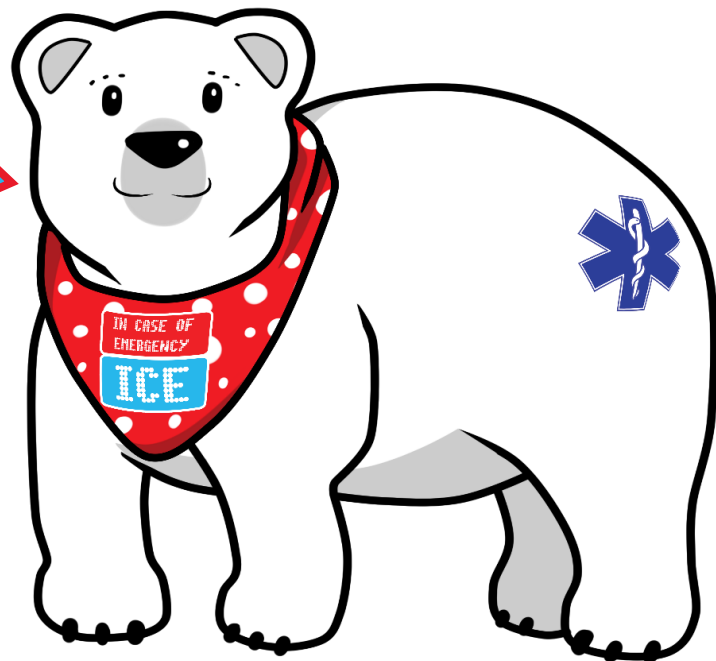
You cannot see it,  
smell it or taste it!

Some of our homes and holiday accommodation (lodges, cabins, chalets, caravans and recreational vehicles) have a gas heater, stove or fireplace so we can stay warm and heat our water in winter.

Gaseous heaters and stoves, with a flame, can be dangerous as they emit large quantities of carbon monoxide (CO) which is a lethal gas that can kill within minutes. It is very important to check that we are living in a safe environment and this includes when we go on holiday.

## BE SAFE!

Check the 'safety certificate' and that the chimney has been swept and all air vents are clear and unblocked.



If you suspect carbon monoxide, open all the windows and go outside - then call the emergency services and ask for Fire & Rescue or Ambulance **IMMEDIATELY**.

Find out what number to dial for your country. Example: 112 in Europe, 911 in North America, 000 in Australia.
